Policies and Procedures

Policies:

- 1. **TEAM** workers are not allowed to leave the campgrounds without approval from the camp office.
- 2. While we encourage good fellowship with peers, we do not want you in a dating situation at camp. We do not allow guy/gal pairing off by our **TEAM** members.

Procedures:

Arrival:

TEAM members should be on duty by 10:00 AM on Monday (unless riding to camp with campers) and may leave duty at noon on Saturday (unless riding with campers). Late arrivals and early departures must have prior approval from the camp office. We ask that **TEAM** members not remain at the camp over the weekend. There will be a \$20 fee for those who need to stay for the weekend, and this must be approved through the **TEAM** director.

Duties:

You are coming as a worker, not as a counselor. We hope to train you in areas of service with the future possibility of being a counselor at camp. You will be required to do a good share of physical work. You will be supervised by a staff member, and you may assist a counselor at times. A willing, servant attitude is a must!

What to bring:

Bible, bedding, towels, toiletries, sport clothes for activities, tennis shoes, swimsuit, jacket, flashlight, notebook, pen, and spending money for the snack shop, gift store, and craft shop (cash cards may be purchased in the office).

What not to bring:

Alcoholic beverages, non-prescription medication, tobacco, media devices, TV's, video games, cell phones, magazines, knives of any kind. State law prohibits food in cabins. Please do not bring extra snacks.

Clothing:

Any clothing worn must be loose-fitting, come to the top of the knee, and cover the shoulders. Tops must be long enough to cover skin at all times no matter what the activity. No low necklines (front or back. Do not bring clothing with questionable advertising. Camp Chetek reserves the right to ask any one to change his/her clothing if in the estimation of the staff it is immodest.

Young Men: Hair off the ear and off the collar, no earrings or necklaces at camp.

Young Ladies: Hair should be cut in a feminine style and be a natural color. Earrings limited to two pair.

Evening Service Attire:

Young Men: Long pants and collared shirt for evening services Monday through Friday.

Young Ladies: Skirt and top or dress (knee length) for evening services Monday through Friday. Jean skirts are fine for evening services.

Christian Conduct:

Camp Chetek reserves the right to set standards of conduct and separation. Separate swim times are scheduled for men and ladies. The camp reserves the right to set standards of conduct concerning boy/girl relationships, dress standards, response to authority, etc. Violators of these standards are subject to dismissal at parents' expense.
